Stop Rights Violations at Nestlé Indonesia!

To Mr. Paul Bulcke, Nestlé CEO

For two years, workers at the Nescafé factory in Indonesia have been seeking the right to negotiate wages through their union, SBNIP, and to have the wage scale included in their collective agreement. No worker right is more fundamental - and it is clearly set out in international law. Nestlé refuses to apply international human rights standards, claims that wages are a "commercial secret", and instead of negotiating, has constantly sought to undermine the union. I call on Nestlé management to immediately and unconditionally enter into genuine negotiations with SBNIP for a new collective agreement, including wage negotiations.

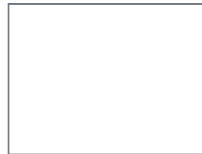
